B730 TARBOLTON ROAD DUNDONALD – CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING WORKS

Carriageway resurfacing works have been programmed to be carried out on the above road as shown on the plan overleaf.

Works are scheduled to begin on **Tuesday 2nd August 2022** and are anticipated to last for three weeks, however I should advise you that the work is weather dependent and unforeseen difficulties could result in a delay. Our intended working hours will be **0800-1700hrs** each day. Every effort will be made to minimise disruption where possible

Access to properties within the works site will be restricted during the working hours, but access from both directions may be maintained when safe to do so.

Our programme is as follows:

Tuesday 2nd and Wednesday 3rd August - Pre works under traffic signals
Thursday 4th August under Road Closure – Phase 1 (Slough Bridge to Tarbolton Road)
Wednesday 10th August under Road Closure – Phase 2 (Dankeith to B751 Junction)

Emergency Vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

Protecting the safety and wellbeing of employees and local residents is of the utmost importance. Therefore vehicle access to properties within the affected area will be strictly prohibited while resurfacing works are in progress. It would be greatly appreciated if vehicle journeys within site limits are avoided or minimised to allow operations to proceed as quickly as possible.
